Hello from the School Nurse! This is a reminder to parents/guardians whose child has medication at school. While we are able to send inhalers and epi-pens home in backpacks, all other medications will need to be picked up at school by a parent or guardian.

Medications can be picked up in the office on the last day of school until 3pm. The office will also be open from 8:00am-3:00pm on June 6th and June 7th for medication pick up, however, please call ahead at 608-842-6200 when picking up to ensure someone is available to assist you.

#### Medications that are not picked up by June 7th will be discarded.

If your child will need medication while at school during the 2024/2025 school year, a new medication administration form will need to be completed.
